Citadel Hires Compliance Boss

Citadel Asset Management has hired **Mark Polemeni**, formerly of **Odyssey Investment Management**, as chief compliance officer. He is slated to start June 6 and will be based in the firm's New York office.

Polemeni will oversee compliance obligations for the hedge fund firm, which is registered as an investment adviser with the **Securities and Exchange Commission** and has roughly \$11 billion in assets under management. He will report to general counsel **John Nagel**. Polemeni's predecessor at Citadel, **Darin Sadow**, left to join a California fund firm, according to a person familiar with the matter. The identity of the firm could not be determined and Sadow could not be reached for comment. According to an SEC filing, Sadow left CAM in March.

A Citadel spokeswoman confirmed Sadow's departure and Polemeni's hire but had no further comment. Polemeni declined to comment. A spokeswoman for Odyssey had no immediate comment.

Polemeni's last day at Odyssey will be June 3. He has been CCO and chief legal officer for Odyssey and parent **Alexandria Investment Management** since 2005. He was previously a partner in the investment management practice of **Epstein Becker & Green**.
